FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I get a bigger cart or a 2nd cart for recycling?

YES! A property owner has the option to exchange the sixty-four (64) gallon recycling cart which was issued at the beginning of 2009 for a ninety-six (96) gallon recycling cart upon paying a one-time non-refundable fee of \$25.00 (fee covers the current contract with Waste Management – through 2013). Pickup would continue to be on a bi-weekly (every two weeks) basis.

A property owner could also choose to get an additional cart (either 64 gallon or 96 gallon). In this case, the owner would pay for the actual cost of pickup (between \$40-\$45 yearly). If the owner chooses this option, an invoice will be sent on a yearly basis.

Is there a special way I should put the recycling cart at the street?

YES! Please place your cart with the lid opening towards the street (hinge away from the street) with a minimum of three feet between any other container or object.

Why does the recycling driver leave my cart in the street after it is emptied?

If the recycling cart is placed on grass, the mechanical arm will catch the grass when it sets the cart back down and often leaves divits in the grass. Also, if the cart does get caught up on the grass, the pressure from the arm can damage the cart. **IF AT ALL POSSIBLE, PLEASE PLACE THE CART ON CONCRETE OR BLACKTOP AND WITHIN THREE FEET OF THE CURB.** If the cart is placed on this type of solid surface, it will be returned to the same place it was picked up from.
