

**Dog and Cat Licensing Information**—Per Wisconsin Statute s. 174.05, the owner of any dog more than five (5) months of age on January 1 of any year, or five (5) months of age within the license year, shall annually, on or before the date the dog becomes five (5) months of age, pay a license tax and obtain a license.

The City of Cedarburg, under City Code 7-1-3, also requires that all cats more than 5 months of age be licensed. The rules applying to the dog licenses also apply to cat licenses.

In compliance with State Statute s. 174.07, NO license will be issued unless current rabies vaccination information is provided, including the dog or cat rabies tag number, date of expiration, owner's name and address and the name, sex, if it is spayed/unspayed, neutered/unneutered, breed and color of the dog or cat. Contact your pet's veterinarian for a copy of the rabies certificate.

A \$5 late fee shall be collected for all dogs and cats not licensed by April 1 of any year or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or cat.

The owner of a dog specially trained to lead the blind or deaf or to provide support for the mobility-impaired must still submit a license application with all required information; however, these dogs are exempt from the regular dog license fee.

**In the event the dog no longer resides in the City of Cedarburg or died before January 31, 2010, you must either pay the license fee or complete the affidavit stating the circumstances and mail to the City Treasurer before April 1, 2010. Affidavits are available online or by contacting the City Treasurer's Office at 375-7607. If you fail to comply by April 1, a delinquent report will be filed with the District Attorney's Office per WI Statute.**
