

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-14

An Ordinance Amending the Ethics Code of the City of Cedarburg

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Cedarburg is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SEC. 2-5-4 FAIR AND EQUAL TREATMENT.

- (a) **Use of Public Property.** No official or employee shall request or permit the unauthorized use of City-owned vehicles, equipment, materials or property for personal convenience or profit.
- (b) **Fundraising.** No official or employee shall request or permit the use of city resources, city time or city equipment for the purpose of fundraising. No official or employee shall use his or her position, authority or influence, whether possessed or anticipated, to represent themselves as a city official or employee for private or public fundraising.
- ~~(b)~~ (c) **Obligations to Citizens.** No official or employee shall grant any special consideration, treatment or advantage to any citizen beyond that which is available to every other citizen.”

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
