

**ORDINANCE 2011-26**

**An Ordinance Levying Property Taxes for the General,  
Debt Service, Special Revenue and Capital Improvement  
Funds of the City of Cedarburg for the Year 2012**

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2011-20, being an Ordinance Levying Property Taxes for the General, Debt Service, Special Revenue and Capital Improvement Funds of the City of Cedarburg for Year 2012, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied a tax of \$7,753,377 on all the taxable property, within the City of Cedarburg as returned by the Assessor in the year 2011, for the uses and purposes set forth in the 2012 budgets as set forth below, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to spend this tax on the current tax roll of the City of Cedarburg.

SECTION 3. The tax to be levied will fund the following purposes:

General Fund (Operating)	\$5,259,335
Capital Improvements	1,090,000
Special Revenue (Library)	490,000
Debt Service	914,042
Total	<u>\$7,753,377</u>

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
