

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012-18**

**An Ordinance Regarding the Composition of  
the Landmarks Commission**

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-4-10(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Cedarburg is hereby amended as follows:

**SEC. 2-4-10 LANDMARKS COMMISSION.**

- (a) **Composition and Terms.** The Commission shall be composed of ~~eight (8)~~ seven (7) members to be selected as follows: One (1) Council Member, and ~~seven (7)~~ six (6) qualified persons, at least six ~~(6)~~ (5) of whom shall be residents of the City of Cedarburg. The ~~seventh (7<sup>th</sup>)~~ sixth (6<sup>th</sup>) member may be either a City resident or the owner of property located within the Washington Avenue Historic District. Said persons shall be competent and informed in the historical, architectural and cultural traditions of the community. They shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg by majority vote. Members of the Commission shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years and may be reappointed for succeeding terms. A vacancy occurring in the membership for any cause shall be filled by a person appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Common Council for the unexpired term. The members of said Commission shall receive no compensation except for necessary expenses sustained in carrying out their duties, which expenses shall be paid by the City of Cedarburg as authorized by the Common Council.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
