NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on **Monday, June 5, 2017** the Plan Commission of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, will hold a PUBLIC HEARING to consider a petition from Martin and Kathleen Schoenknecht requesting a Conditional Use Permit to use the three (3) apartment units in the rear yard of the property located at W63 N667 Washington Avenue as either Tourist Rooming House units or rental units.

The site is zoned B-3 Central Business District/HPD Historic Preservation Overlay District. Pursuant to Municipal Code Section 13-1-55(e)(20), Tourist Rooming Houses are allowed as a Conditional Use in the B-3 District after review and approval by the Plan Commission.

The Plan Commission meeting on **Monday, June 5, 2017 begins at 7:00 p.m.** and will be held in the Council Chambers at the Cedarburg City Hall, located at W63 N645 Washington Avenue. Interested persons wishing to be heard are invited to attend. If you are unable to attend, written comments may be submitted to the City Clerk's Office prior to the hearing.

Plans are available for review in the City Planner's Office weekdays during regular business hours.
