

would be lit. The original “Studebaker” sign was neon, which is not permitted today in Cedarburg. Ideally the sign could be designed in such a way that if the tenant changed, the lettering on the sign would only have to be changed. If the proposed sign does not meet Code, that will be handled by the Plan Commission and the City Building Inspector. There was also a proposal for an additional smaller projecting sign of the scale frequently found in Cedarburg.

Tomi Fay Forbes made a motion to accept the plans as presented; subject to the signage lighting and material return for review and approval in the future. Council Member Thome seconded the motion. Motion carried without a negative vote with Tom Kubala, James Pape and Allison Hanson excused.
