

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-25

**An Ordinance Increasing the Fees for Operator's Licenses
and Establishing a Fee for Color Copies**

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7-2-5 (b)(7) of the City of Cedarburg Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

SEC. 7-2-5 LICENSE FEES.

(b) **License Fees.** The following license fees shall be charged for licenses issued by the Common Council for the sale of intoxicating liquors and fermented malt beverages within the City. All such fees are payable after approval of the application by the Common Council and prior to the release of the license being delivered to the licensee, with the exception of Temporary Class B Licenses and Operator's Licenses, for which the fee shall be paid at the time the application is submitted.

(7) Operator's License -- ~~Thirty Dollars (\$30.00)~~ Thirty five dollars (\$35.00) per year. In addition, there shall be a Ten Dollar (\$10) application fee for all new operator's licenses.

SECTION 2. Section 7-2-23 of the City of Cedarburg Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

SEC. 7-2-23 OPERATOR'S LICENSE FEE.

The fee for renewal of an operator's license shall be ~~Thirty Dollars (\$30.00)~~ Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) per year. The application fee for a new operator's license shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and the fee for a new operator's license shall be ~~Thirty Dollars (\$30.00)~~ Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00), for a total charge of ~~Forty Dollars (\$40.00)~~ Forty Five Dollars (\$45). All fees are due at the time of application. There shall be a \$10 fee for all renewal applications received after July 1.

SECTION 3. Section 3-3-4(f)(1) of the City of Cedarburg Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

SEC. 3-3-4 PUBLIC ACCESS TO RECORDS.

(f) A requester shall be charged a fee for each page to defray the cost of copying records as follows:

(1) Each single-sided black and white page -- Twenty-five Cents (25¢). Each single-sided color copy page -- Fifty Cents (50¢).


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2016 upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
