RESOLUTION NO. 2014-08**

A Resolution Honoring City Attorney Kaye K. Vance

WHEREAS, Attorney Kaye K. Vance began her service as City Attorney with the City of Cedarburg in May of 1992; and

WHEREAS, Attorney Kaye K. Vance has provided legal counsel to five Mayors, dozens of Council Members, three City Administrators, and numerous other City staff members throughout her tenure; and

WHEREAS, during her 22 years of dedicated public service, Attorney Kaye K. Vance has carefully and capably served the Common Council and staff of the City Cedarburg; and has demonstrated the highest principles of law while exhibiting high moral and ethical standards; and

WHEREAS, Attorney Kaye K. Vance has attended literally hundreds, perhaps thousands, of board, committee, and commission meetings during her 22 year tenure as City Attorney, including Common Council, Plan Commission, Personnel Committee, Board of Appeals, and Board of Review meetings; and

WHEREAS, Attorney Kaye K. Vance has always shown the utmost respect for the Wisconsin Open Meetings and Public Records laws; and

WHEREAS, the following are major accomplishments of Attorney Kaye K. Vance while City Attorney, just to name a few: creation of TID No. 1 and TID No. 2 in the City; assisted with several annexations and property rezonings; drafted many ordinances that were adopted by the Common Council, including an Ethics Ordinance, Impact Fee Ordinance, and Concealed Carry Ordinance; prepared a Grievance policy, drafted numerous development agreements; provided prosecution services; was involved in negotiations regarding the purchase of the property on Pioneer Road for a future Wastewater Treatment Plant, defended the City in court proceedings, including *Marris v. the City of Cedarburg* and the tourist rooming house cases; handled litigation regarding the Prochnow Landfill, negotiated numerous union contracts; negotiated and re-negotiated agreements with the City of Mequon and Ozaukee Youth Hockey Association; began negotiations with the Town of Cedarburg and Mercury Marine to begin engineering for the Prochnow Landfill; worked with the DNR, EPA, Mercury Marine regarding the clean-up of the Plant No. 2 site and the Amcast site; and negotiated shared services agreements with the Town of Cedarburg;

WHEREAS, Attorney Kaye K. Vance demonstrated sound legal judgment and provided timely legal advice in matters involving the City of Cedarburg; and her integrity, courtesy, and professionalism earned her the respect of the Mayor, Common Council, staff, and citizens of the City of Cedarburg; and

WHEREAS, the Cedarburg Community has benefited significantly from the dedication, knowledge, skills, service, and excellence in law of **Attorney Kaye K. Vance**.
