A Resolution Honoring Paul A. Radtke

WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke has conscientiously completed eleven years of service as 4th District Council Member from 2004-2015 and three years as Council President from 2011-2013 and 2014-2015 for the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke, as Council Member, has served on the following, as well as various ad hoc committees, with dedication and distinction, marked by exemplary and energetic leadership:

WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke put forth effort to keep his constituents informed and to encourage citizens' involvement and input in an open government forum; and

WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke, as a member of the Common Council, was influential in completion of the following projects: adoption of Intergovernmental Agreements, expansion of the Creek Walk, the creation of Tax Incremental District #2, financing of a new public library, adoption of the Smart Growth Comprehensive Land Use Plan - 2025, establishing ward numbering and boundary redistricting associated with the 2010 Census, a revised and approved agreement with the City of Mequon and the Ozaukee Youth Hockey Association, implementing a revised Impact Fee Ordinance, adopting a Concealed Carry Ordinance, adopting Grievance, Cell Phone, EAP, Electronic Media Device and Employee Evaluation policies, selecting a site and construction of a new Library, selecting a mediator with the Town of Cedarburg in an attempt to continue sharing services and negotiate a Comprehensive Border Agreement, supporting improvements to the Ozaukee County Fairgrounds to include a multi-purpose building and addition/renovation to the 4-H Building, awarding banking services contracts, Personnel Code revisions due to Act 10, selecting a new health insurance provider, selecting a telephone replacement system, creating an updated website, selecting a City Attorney, authorizing the sale of the former library building, the creation of Tax Incremental District #3, creating a Public Art Commission; and

WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke was instrumental in facilitating ten annexations, approving six Revolving Loan Fund loans, approving a new loan program for economic development, advocating for the downtown business owners; and


WHEREAS, Paul A. Radtke made conscientious efforts to control spending and keep taxes low in the City; and
