

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-06

A Resolution Directing the Plan Commission to Furnish Three Citizen Members to Serve on the Joint Extraterritorial Zoning Committee; Calling Upon the Town of Cedarburg to Appoint Its Members to Such Committee; and Directing the City Members to Proceed with the Town of Cedarburg Members of Such Committee to Formulate a District Plan and Zoning Regulations for the Area of Extraterritorial Zoning Jurisdiction of the City of Cedarburg Within the Town of Cedarburg

WHEREAS, the general health, welfare and safety of the City of Cedarburg and its residents are dependant upon the proper relationship and control of land uses within the areas immediately surrounding and adjacent to the City which are economically and socially integrated with the life and economic pursuits of the residents of the City of Cedarburg, or will in the future become so interdependent; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Wis. Stat. 62.23(7a), provides for the control of land use within areas surrounding and adjacent to incorporated municipalities by procedures set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cedarburg has created a Plan Commission and adopted a Zoning Code under Wis. Stat. 62.23(1) and (7), as required as a prerequisite under Wis. Stat. 62.23(7a), for the exercise of extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2006, the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg, pursuant to Wis. Stat. 62.23(7a), unanimously approved Resolution No. 2006-05 declaring its intent to exercise extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction within that portion of the Town of Cedarburg as determined pursuant to Wis. Stat. 62.23(7a) and as specifically described in said Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg does resolve:

1. That the City of Cedarburg Plan Commission be and is hereby directed to proceed with constituting the Joint Extraterritorial Zoning Committee, by the selection of three of its citizen members to serve on such Joint Extraterritorial Zoning Committee;
2. That the Town of Cedarburg is hereby called upon and requested to appoint to such committee its three representative members;
3. That the Plan Commission, by its City members of the Joint Extraterritorial zoning committee, be and are hereby directed to work with the Town of Cedarburg members of such Committee to formulate a comprehensive district plan and zoning regulations for the area described in Resolution No. 2006-05, hold public hearing thereon as required by law, and refer its recommendations for such plan and zoning regulations to
