A Resolution Recognizing City Administrator Patrick Boyle

WHEREAS, Patrick Boyle began employment as City Administrator with the City of Cedarburg on March 7, 2005; and

WHEREAS, during this time, Patrick Boyle has conscientiously and capably served the City of Cedarburg and its citizens by overseeing citywide operations as directed by the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Boyle also facilitated communication between elected officials and city staff, managed personnel issues, recruited three new employees, responded to insurance claims, gathered information for the creation of TID #2, and championed positive inter-municipal relationships; and
