RESOLUTION 2007-34

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A
RELOCATION ORDER AND RIGHT-OF-WAY PLAT
FOR PHASE I OF THE CEDAR CREEK WALKWAY**

WHEREAS, the City of Cedarburg is planning to construct a walkway along certain areas on the westerly bank of Cedar Creek; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to phase the construction to first complete a short segment immediately south of Bridge Road as well as a segment immediately north of the interurban trail adjacent to Advent Church; and

WHEREAS, prior to beginning the project, the Common Council shall adopt a right-of-way plat and approve a relocation order describing the limits of the project and identifying the properties affected in phase one;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg does hereby adopt the right-of-way plat, approve the relocation order, and declare necessity pertaining to easements to be procured by the City for phase one of the Cedar Creek Walkway Project as described on the right-of-way plat using the eminent domain process.
