WHEREAS, Sandra M. Beck has conscientiously completed eight years of service to the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin as 5th District Council Member from 2000-08 and four years as Council Representative to the Plan Commission from 2004-08; and

WHEREAS, Sandra M. Beck previously was a citizen member of the Library Board from 1990-2000; and
