Glamm, as Council Member, was influential in completion of the following projects: facilitating several annexations and rezonings, including annexation of the property north of the City to facilitate a business park; adoption of Intergovernmental Agreements; the hiring of a City Administrator, City Administrator/Treasurer, City Clerk, and Director of Parks and Recreation; establishing an Economic Development Coordinator position in the City; expansion of the Cedar Creek Walkway; creation of Tax Incremental District #2; financing of a new public library; adoption of the Smart Growth Comprehensive Land Use Plan – 2025; adoption of a Neighborhood Electric Vehicle (NEV) ordinance; implementation of an emerald ash borer treatment program; approval of a Whistle Blowing Policy; establishment of a Wellness Program for City Employees; adoption of an ordinance pertaining to employee benefits for private business; approval of Cedarburg’s first canine unit for the Police Department; approval of a Restricted/Modified Duty Assignment Policy; approval of an Employee Eligibility Verification Policy; and establishing a Sister City relationship between the City of Cedarburg and Corciano, Italy; and

**WHEREAS**, Steven H. Glamm, during his tenure with the City demonstrated and encouraged a proactive approach in dealing with municipal government issues, and citizens have greatly benefited from his commitment; and
