

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-01

DECLARING INTENT TO LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS PURSUANT TO §66.0701 AND §66.0703 WISCONSIN STATE STATUTES

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, properties on the east side of Washington Avenue from Cambridge Avenue to a point approximately 390 feet north of Susan Lane will benefit from the following public work and improvements:

Construction of new concrete curb and gutter in conjunction with the reconstruction of Washington Avenue.

1. The City intends to exercise its assessment powers to recover costs it will incur in the construction of the above public work and improvements.
2. The initial proportion of the costs to be assessed shall not exceed the total cost of construction, engineering and inspection.
3. The Director of Public Works shall prepare a report, which shall consist of:
 - a. Final plans and specifications for the improvements.
 - b. An estimate of the entire cost of the improvements.
 - c. An estimate as to each parcel of property within the assessment district of:
 - 1) The assessment of benefits to be levied for the improvement.
 - 2) The damages to be awarded for any property taken or damaged by the improvement.
 - 3) The net amount of benefits over damages or of damages over benefits for the improvements.
 - 4) The total assessments against each parcel
4. When the report is completed, the Director of Public Works shall file a copy of the report with the City Clerk for public inspection.
5. Upon receiving the report, the clerk shall cause notice to be given stating the nature of the proposed Assessment District, including a map thereof, the time and place at which the report may be inspected, and a time and place of the public hearing on the matters contained in the preliminary resolution and the report. This notice shall be published as a class 1 notice under ch. 985, Wis. Stats., and a copy shall be mailed, at least ten days before the hearing, to every interested party whose address is known or can be ascertained with reasonable diligence.

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6. The hearing shall be held in the Cedarburg City Hall at the following address: W65 N645 Washington Avenue at a time set by the City Clerk in accordance with §66.0703, Stats.
7. The assessment against any parcel may be paid in a lump sum or in annual installments the number of which shall be determined at the public hearing on the proposed assessments.
