A Resolution Honoring Patrol Officer Robert L. Van Dinter, Jr.

WHEREAS, Robert L. Van Dinter, Jr. has completed thirty years of employment with the Cedarburg Police Department; beginning his employment as a Dispatcher on June 2, 1980; Patrol Officer on April 2, 1984; and

WHEREAS, during his thirty years of service, four years as a dispatcher and twenty-six years as a patrol officer, Robert “Bob” Van Dinter, Jr. has conscientiously and capably served the Cedarburg Police Department, the City of Cedarburg, and its citizens; and has demonstrated the highest principles of community service while exhibiting high moral and ethical standards; and

WHEREAS, Officer Van Dinter demonstrated sound judgment and decision-making in matters involving the Cedarburg Police Department; and his integrity, courtesy, and professionalism earned him the respect of the community, his co-workers, and peers; and
