**WHEREAS**, Kip D. Kinzel has conscientiously completed nine years of service to the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin as 6<sup>th</sup> District Council Member from 2002-11 and two years as Council President from 2009-11; and

**WHEREAS**, Kip D. Kinzel, as Council Member, has served on the following, as well as various ad hoc committees, with dedication and distinction, marked by exemplary and energetic leadership:

Kinzel, as Council Member, was influential in completion of the following projects: facilitating several annexations and rezonings, including annexation of the property north of the City to facilitate a business park; adoption of Intergovernmental Agreements; hiring of a City Administrator/Treasurer, City Clerk, and Director of Parks and Recreation; establishing an Economic Development Coordinator position in the City; expansion of the Cedar Creek Walkway; creation of Tax Incremental District #2; financing of a new public library; adoption of the Smart Growth Comprehensive Land Use Plan – 2025; adoption of a Neighborhood Electric Vehicle (NEV) ordinance; implementation of an emerald ash borer treatment program; approval of a Whistle Blowing Policy; establishment of a Wellness Program for City Employees; adoption of an ordinance pertaining to employee benefits for private business; approval of Cedarburg’s first canine unit for the Police Department; approval of a Restricted/Modified Duty Assignment Policy; approval of an Employee Eligibility Verification Policy; adoption of an ordinance relating to sex offender residency restrictions and child safety zones; adoption of ordinance to modify term limits for the Mayor and Council Members; conceptually establishing a Sister City relationship between the City of Cedarburg and Corciano, Italy; adoption of a Park and Open Space Plan; adoption of a smoking ban ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, Kip D. Kinzel, during his tenure with the City demonstrated and encouraged a proactive approach in dealing with municipal government issues, and citizens have greatly benefited from his commitment; and

**WHEREAS**, Kip D. Kinzel made conscientious efforts to control spending and keep taxes low in the City.
