A Resolution Honoring Mayor Gregory P. Myers

WHEREAS, Gregory P. Myers has completed three terms as Mayor for the City of Cedarburg, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, during his 9-year tenure, Gregory P. Myers has conscientiously and capably served the City of Cedarburg and its citizens in a variety of capacities:

Mayor – 2003-2012  
Chair, Plan Commission – 2003-2012      Chair, Public Works Commission – 2003-2012

WHEREAS, Gregory P. Myers represented the City of Cedarburg by assisting Cedarburg Light & Water and WPPI by working with our Senators/Representatives in Washington, DC on issues important to the Community and participating in the Mid-Moraine Municipal Association; and

WHEREAS, Gregory P. Myers was influential in the completion of significant projects including creation of a Public Art Committee, supporting expansion of the Creek Walk, adopting the National Incident Management System, the creation of TID #2, approving an Inter-Municipal Agreement with the Village of Grafton for water and sewer services, authorizing the City to enter into a Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS) agreement, establishing ward numbering and boundary redistricting associated with the 2010 Census, engaging in discussions with neighboring communities regarding shared services, a revised and approved agreement with the City of Mequon and the Ozaukee Youth Hockey Association, implementing a revised Impact Fee Ordinance, adopting a Concealed Carry Ordinance and Grievance Policy, selecting an engineering firm with the Town of Cedarburg to begin work on the Prochnow property, selecting a library site, participating in mediation with the Town of Cedarburg in an attempt to continue sharing services and negotiate a Comprehensive Border Agreement, Approved \$800,000 borrowing through the State Trust Fund loan program using the Build America Bonds designation, supporting improvements to the Ozaukee County Fairgrounds to include a multi-purpose building and addition/renovation to the 4-H Building, adopting updated I-9, FMLA and Document Destruction policies, awarding banking services contracts; and

WHEREAS, Gregory P. Myers was instrumental in holding the City tax rate level for six out of nine years in office; implementing the Smart Growth Comprehensive Land Use Plan – 2025; facilitating nine annexations; advocating for the downtown business owners; hosting annual Mayor's Enhancement Award events; and

WHEREAS, the leadership of Gregory P. Myers has been a positive influence for the good in the growth and progress of this community, earning him the great respect of his constituents, the Common Council and city staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg hereby joins the citizens of the City of Cedarburg and city staff in expressing their sincere appreciation to Gregory P. Myers for his commendable public service and his many contributions to the cause of representative local government.
