A Resolution Honoring Cedarburg Light & Water Commissioner Charles T. Bradburn

WHEREAS, during his sixty years of service as a utility commissioner, Charles T. Bradburn has conscientiously and capably served the Cedarburg Light & Water Utility, the City of Cedarburg, and its citizens; and has demonstrated the highest principles of community service while exhibiting high moral and ethical standards; and
