A Resolution Honoring Edward Bublitz

WHEREAS, Edward Bublitz has completed nearly eighteen years of employment as an operator with the City of Cedarburg; beginning his employment at the Wastewater Treatment Plant on July 24, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Edward Bublitz began as an Operator 1 and advanced to an Operator II position, while becoming certified in all subcategories assigned to the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant and has attained the level of Grade 4, the highest level that the DNR gives for treatment plant operators; and

WHEREAS, Edward Bublitz has conscientiously and capably served the City of Cedarburg and its citizens by maintaining the wastewater treatment plant, laboratory, lift stations and sanitary sewers to assure the effluent discharge into Cedar Creek consistently meets limits established by the WPDES Permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources; and

WHEREAS, Edward Bublitz in addition to his regular duties, worked on repairing and maintaining backflow preventers for the City facilities. He also spent many hours behind the wheel of snowplows and graders for the Department of Public Works when snow removal was needed; and

WHEREAS, Edward Bublitz generously contributed to the safety of the citizens of Cedarburg by serving many years on the Cedarburg Fire Department responding to fire calls and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Cedarburg have greatly benefited from the dedicated skills of Edward Bublitz; and his integrity, courtesy, and professionalism have earned him the respect of the community, his co-workers, and peers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Cedarburg and the citizens of the City join in expressing their sincere appreciation to Edward Bublitz for his contributions to the City of Cedarburg operations and infrastructure and extend their best wishes to him for a well-deserved and enjoyable retirement.
