Discuss Effects of COVID-19 on Local Businesses and Ideas to Help; and Action Thereon

Council Member Arnett circulated a memo on re-opening Cedarburg. He asked if there should be specific areas that the City should be focusing on as we look at re-opening. Discussion ensued on the pros and cons of reopening Cedarburg sooner than the Safer at Home directive was lifted. Consensus was that it was important to give our businesses the opportunity to open if they chose to do so but it was also important that they do so safely. This included having them follow the CDC and Ozaukee Health Department Guidelines for opening. Council Member Arnett shared the results of a community wide survey he put together that showed the majority of Cedarburg residents favored opening up local businesses and would visit them if they had proper safety measures in place. It was also brought up that the City should inform the businesses to check with their own attorneys and insurance companies on how opening would affect their business.

DJ Burns gave a brief history on the site. Without the DNR approving Mercury Marine's final submission on remediation of the area there is nothing the City can do. The City will continue to communicate with Mercury Marine on the site and look at potential future uses.
