UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Discussion and Possible Action on a Strategic Plan for the Committee

South End of Washington Avenue

Council Member Burkart understands that most people want more restaurants in this area.

City Administrator Hilvo stated that there are not many tools available to incentivize businesses beyond conversations. This area needs a strong anchor at the south entrance to the City to draw more businesses to the area. The City is hopeful that Dunkin Go will create further interest in this area. He added that the hotel/restaurant combination on Pioneer Road is still in discussions; however, nothing concrete has been decided.

Mark Roller suggested that it might be helpful to brand the area rather than referring to it as the south end of Cedarburg. He also suggested a possible dog park on the City property between the church and Echo Plaza.

It was the consensus of the Board that a recreation center would be a good fit for the property on Pioneer Road in front of the future Water Recycling Center. City Administrator Hilvo explained that various recreation groups could get together and discuss a possible joint venture for a recreation facility.

Discussion and Possible Action on Smart Growth Area #1

It was suggested that the Community Development Authority be involved in the direction of this property.

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion and Possible Action on Golf Cart Use in the City

City Administrator Hilvo explained that current policy does not allow golf carts in the City. All golf carts would need to be regulated the same as an automobile. City Administrator Hilvo will speak with Police Chief McNerney and possibly draft an ordinance for Common Council consideration.
