CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kinzel called the meeting to order at 6:38 p.m.

<u>REVIEW AND CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES FROM ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING</u> (JANUARY 25, 2018)

Motion made by Ms. Geracie, seconded by Mr. Lorge, to approve the minutes of the January 25, 2018 organizational meeting. Motion carried with Ms. Bonaparte absent.

REVIEW THE PUBLIC RECORD, PLANNING DOCUMENTS, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION AND COMMON COUNCIL RESOLUTION

Mr. Taves said the minutes of the January 25, 2018 Joint Review Board and resolutions adopted by the Community Development Authority on January 25, 2018 and Common Council on February 12, 2018 were distributed to the members prior to the meeting. The CDA held a public hearing at its meeting on January 25, 2018. The Common Council approved the creation of the TID on February 12, 2018. The project plan has not changed since the last Joint Review Board meeting. The final step in the creation of TID No. 5 is approval of a resolution by the Joint Review Board.

Mr. Taves said Ehlers was also retained to review the economic projections and financial returns for the proposed 69 unit Arrabelle apartment complex proposed at the south end of Washington Avenue. The conclusion of the analysis is that the investment returns as projected are not within, but actually below market ranges. Therefore, but for the TIF assistance, this project would not proceed as designed, or within the timeframe anticipated.
