

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5-4-5(c)  
OF CITY OF CEDARBURG CODE OF ORDINANCES  
RELATING TO PERMITS FOR PRIVATE ALARM SYSTEMS

The Common Council of the City of Cedarburg do ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 5-4-5(c) of the City Code of the City of Cedarburg is hereby repealed as follows:


**SEC. 5-4-5 Permit for Private Alarm Systems.**

(c) ~~Direct police connection permit fee.~~ A \$240.00 permit fee shall be paid to the chief of police at the time of filing said application for all business and residential alarm permits who want direct connection to the police department. The permit fee shall be based on a calendar year and pro-rated on a monthly basis. Said fee shall be billed annually by the city treasurer's office by January 30 of each year. Failure to make payment of the permit fee by March 1 of each year will result in the discontinuance of the alarm system permit.

**SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.** The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.


